CULTIVATING A LIFESTYLE OF PRAYER & FASTING

Very early in the morning, while it was still dark, Jesus got up, left the house and went off to a solitary place, where He prayed.

MARK 1:35

Prayer is most effective when it isn't something we do every now and then, but when it's a lifestyle we cultivate. To understand how to have a lifestyle of prayer, we can look at the example Jesus gave during His life on earth.

HAVE A CERTAIN TIME

Jesus got up early in the morning to spend time with His Heavenly Father. Make a daily appointment with God — whether it's first thing in the morning, at lunch, or in the evening — and faithfully keep it.

HAVE A CERTAIN PLACE

Jesus had a specific place He went to pray. Having a designated place to pray helps us remove distractions and frees us to worship and pray out loud.

HAVE A CERTAIN PLAN

When Jesus taught His disciples how to pray, He gave them a prayer outline. We call it "The Lord's Prayer." As we pray every day, our plans for our prayer time can vary, maybe including worship music, Bible reading, and quiet time to listen to God. It doesn't always have to look the same; it just helps when we have a plan for connecting regularly with God.

Fasting Guidelines

In Isaiah 58, God ordained fasting to (1) loosen the bonds of wickedness in our lives; (2) undo heavy burdens in the lives of others; (3) help the oppressed be set free as we minister to them by the anointing of the Spirit; (4) break every yoke of the religious spirit; (5) give bread to the hungry and provide the poor with housing; (6) allow the light of revelation in God's Word to break forth in us like the morning; (7) allow our emotional and physical health to speedily spring forth; (8) cause righteousness to break forth in the places where we struggle; and (9) cause the glory and power of the Lord to operate in our ministries.

What is Fasting?

In the scripture, Fasting is primarily to abstain from food. It is intentionally concentrating on the Lord, His holiness, His Kingdom, and His will. Normally, when a person is full of food, the desires of the physical body are very strong as well as the desires of the soul—that is, the will, the mind and the emotions. During fasting the desires of the body are greatly reduced and the spirit rises and soars, controlling the soul. This means that spiritual reality is more easily discerned by a fasting person than by one who is not fasting.

How to Fast

There never was a question in the mind of the Lord Jesus about the importance of fasting. He demonstrated His evaluation of the ministry of fasting by His own forty-day fast. He, however, taught very clearly how to fast. He taught saying,

“And when you fast, do not look dismal, like the hypocrites, for they disfigure their faces that their fasting may be seen by men. Truly I say to you, they have received their reward. But when you fast, anoint your head and wash your face, that your fasting may not be seen by men but by your Father who is in secret; and your Father who sees in secret will reward you” (Matthew 6:16-18).

The Lord Jesus said “when you fast” and not “if your fast.” He took for granted that all who are His would fast. He addressed Himself to three important questions about fasting.

The first question was: how should a person look during a fast?

In answering this question, the Lord divided those who fasted into two classes, eg., the hypocrites and His children. It is interesting to know that in all religions people fast. Fasting is therefore not automatically evidence of genuine spirituality. There are unbelievers who fast: Muslims, Hindus, Buddhists, etc. They fast for varying reasons.

The Lord had in mind a class of people, the Pharisees. When they fasted, they disfigured their faces. They made sure that their looks were different. They were not satisfied with the natural impact that fasting produced on the body. They were afraid that it might not serve their purpose.

The Lord said that those who were His were to be different. They were not to look dismal. They were to wash and anoint their faces. In other words, their external appearance was to be given special attention so that it did not draw attention to their fasting.

The same lesson is applicable today. Believers who fast must pay special attention to their physical appearance. They should be clean. They should wear clean clothes. They should bathe at least once a day. They should brush their teeth once every two hours. Fasting people have a special mouth odor. They cannot afford to burden other people with it.

The second question was: who should see the fast?

Here again there were two different attitudes--that of the hypocrites and that of those who belonged to the Lord. The hypocrites fasted in order to catch the eye of man. They therefore did everything to ensure that man would not mistake the fact that

they were fasting. That is why they disfigured their faces. The aim of their fasting was that they might be seen by men.

They fasted to impress men. Their preoccupation during the fast was, Have people seen that I am fasting? Have they seen how long I have fasted? Who has actually seen that I am fasting? They possibly thought of the various people whom they wanted to impress and made sure that somehow those people knew.

Those who belong to Jesus are to fast not to catch the eye of man, but the eye of God. They are to fast so that their fasting is seen by their Father Who is in heaven! Can you see the enormous difference between fasting to be seen by man and fasting to be seen by the Lord? How foolish to fast in order to be seen by man! Yet these people fasted for that purpose and many today fast to be seen by man.

The third question was: who rewards the fasting person?

The Lord Jesus taught clearly that the rewarder of the fasting person is the one whose eye the fasting person wanted to catch. The hypocrite fasted to catch the eye of man. So man is the rewarder of the fasting hypocrite. Anyone who fasts in order to be seen by man is a hypocrite! He receives his rewards from the people who see his fast and sing his praise.

Those who are Christ's fast so as to be seen by their Father, Who is in secret. He is not to be seen with human eyes. He is in secret and He sees all that goes on in secret. Those who fast for His glory labor to ensure that their fasting is seen only by Him. They want to catch His eye, and they want His reward.

The hypocrite's fast is rewarded by the congratulations and the admiration of men. The fasting of those who are truly the Lord's is rewarded by the One who sees in secret. The hypocrite has already obtained his reward. He received it when people looked at his

disfigured face and exclaimed, “What a fasting man!” The reward of the one who fasts in secret is in the future essentially, even though he may have some of it now.

Types of Fast

You are free to fast however the Spirit leads you.
Here are some options.

FULL FAST – Abstain from solid food and beverages for 24hrs.

Take only water, avoid juices, or stimulant like coffee due to its acidic content, or milk.

PARTIAL FAST – Abstain from solid food for an extended part of the day. Take only water. You may fast from sunrise to sundown or from breakfast to afternoon tea.

Daniel Fast - abstains from delicacies, meats, and wines and focuses on fresh foods such as fruits and vegetables

Absolute/Supernatural Fast - This fast involves abstaining from any food or liquids, including water (the fast of Moses and Jesus)

Preparing myself Spiritually

1. Enter into fasting with positive faith – Heb. 11:6, Matt. 6:18.
You have a scriptural right to expect that God will reward you.
2. Plan your spiritual feeding. May be you can read a portion of a book day and night, or listen to sermon. Things that will help you stay motivated.
3. Do not wait for some emergency to fast – Ps. 84:7;
4. In the beginning, do not set yourself too long a period of fasting. Move on gradually to longer periods.
5. During your fast, give plenty of time to reading the Bible
6. It’s helpful to set certain objectives of your fast in written form.
7. Avoid religious ostentation and boastfulness. Life and conduct should be as normal and unpretentious as possible. Fasting doesn’t earn you any merit badges from God.
8. Keep a watchful check on your motives – Is. 58:1-12.

Physically Preparing for a fast

1. Resist the urge to have that 'last big feast' before the fast. Cutting down on your meals a few days before you begin the fast will signal your mind, stomach, and appetite that less food is acceptable. Weaning yourself off caffeine and sugar products will ease your initial hunger or discomfort at the early stages of your fast.
2. If on regular medication, consult medical advice beforehand.
3. In early period of a fast: dizziness, headache, nausea. After a day or two, these symptoms will subside.
4. Guard against constipation. Add Lemon to water.
5. It's scriptural to abstain from food and water, but this should be under the firm directive of the Holy Spirit. It should also not exceed 72 hours.
6. Break your fast gradually. Fasts over 2 days will cause your stomach to shrink. Do not over-expand it again. For health reason, you should consume small portions as you break fast, avoiding chilli or acidic food as much as possible.
7. Identify distractions like television, social media, games, etc. You should do this before you start the fast.

PRAYER TARGETS

1. PRAY FOR PERSONAL REVIVAL & WALK WITH GOD

1. Fear of the Lord

Pray for a holy, reverent fear of God—a deep awe that leads to obedience, wisdom, and delight in pleasing Him (Proverbs 9:10).

2. Love for God Above All Else

Pray for a wholehearted love for God—loving Him with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength (Mark 12:30).

3. Holiness & Consecration

Pray for lives set apart for God—purified motives, surrendered habits, and a desire to live holy as He is holy.

4. Sensitivity to the Holy Spirit

Pray for hearts that are tender and responsive to the Holy Spirit—quick to obey, slow to resist, and eager to follow His leading.

5. Humility & Teachability

Pray for humility of heart—freedom from pride, defensiveness, and self-reliance—and a teachable spirit before God and others.

6. Endurance & Faithfulness

Pray for spiritual endurance—to remain faithful in trials, consistent in prayer, and steadfast in seasons of waiting (Hebrews 12:1).

7. Hunger for God's Word & Prayer

Pray for a growing hunger for Scripture and prayer—not out of duty, but out of desire to know God deeply.

8. Walking in Love Toward Others

Pray for grace to walk in love, patience, kindness, forgiveness, and compassion toward all people, especially in difficult relationships (Colossians 3:12–14).

9. Integrity in Private & Public Life

Pray for integrity—being the same before God in private as we are before people in public.

10. Freedom from Sin & Distraction

Pray for deliverance from sin, compromise, and distractions that weaken intimacy with God.

11. Growth in Christlikeness

Pray that the character of Christ would be formed in us—producing the fruit of the Spirit in everyday life (Gal 5:22–23)

12. Perseverance to Finish Well

Pray for grace to finish well—remaining faithful, joyful, and fruitful until the end of our race (2 Timothy 4:7).

2. PRAY FOR PERSONAL FINANCIAL FREEDOM

1. God's Lordship Over Our Finances

Pray that we would fully surrender our finances to God—acknowledging Him as our Provider, Source, and Owner.

2. Divine Provision & Miracle Supply

Pray for supernatural provision, unexpected favor, and miracle supply—trusting God to meet every need according to His riches in glory.

3. A Heart of Generous Giving

Pray for cheerful, obedient, and generous hearts—honoring God with our firstfruits and supporting His work.

4. Wisdom for Financial Decisions

Pray for wisdom and discernment in every financial decision—spending, borrowing, lending, and managing resources.

5. Cultivating a habit to hear God to be conscious of sowing

Pray for faith to sow consistently into God's Kingdom, believing for a harvest according to His Word.

6. Faithful Stewardship

Pray that we would steward finances responsibly—managing what God has entrusted to us with integrity and excellence.

7. Self-Discipline & Contentment

Pray for self-control, contentment, and freedom from greed, impulsive spending, and comparison.

8. Perseverance in Financial Growth

Pray for perseverance and patience—remaining faithful in financial principles even when results take time.

9. Vision & Purpose

Pray for God-given vision for finances—seeing beyond survival toward purpose, generosity, and long-term impact.

10. Planning & Order

Pray for clarity, discipline, and order in budgeting, planning, and managing finances wisely.

11. Wisdom to Save

Pray for grace to save faithfully—preparing for future needs, seasons, and opportunities.

12. Debt Freedom & Zero Balance

Pray for supernatural breakthroughs, disciplined repayment, and complete freedom from debt—declaring a zero balance in Jesus' name. Pray for people to develop a mindskin that learn debt free habits. A renewed, biblical mindskin about debt, credit, and borrowing (Prov. 11:15, 22:7, Rom. 13:6-8)

13. Wisdom & Favor in Investing

Pray for wisdom, patience, and favor in investing—avoiding reckless gain and pursuing long-term, ethical growth.

14. Peace & Trust in God

Pray for peace over our finances—freedom from anxiety, fear, and striving—choosing to trust God fully.

3. PRAY OVER PROPHETIC WORDS TO IFC

1. **Apostolic & Prophetic House.** A multi-cultural, Multi-Ethnic house that is founded on Apostolic and Prophetic mandate. A house the welcomes and celebrates the five fold ministry call of Ephesians 4 to equip, strength, and growth the local church.

2. **School of the prophets-** Training people to hear God's Voice. Raising up a prophetic army to influence the seven mountains of society. Mentor difference styles and facets of prophetic ministry. People who know and understand the joyful sounds of the feasts of the Lord. People who are mature in dreams and visions. People who are carrying fresh water and living bread.

3. **New Sound in Worship** - A house that welcomes creativity, prophetic anointing, and Holy Spirit move in the areas of music and arts.

6. **House of Restoration.** Anointing for restoration of broken families and leaders. Restoration of wounded, lost, stolen sheep. Restoration of dreams. A place where dreams come alive.

7. **Epicenter of Revival Rain** – God has been preparing a people who will host moves of God for this city. People are crying out for a place that will be able to host and handle for present and future. Pastor a revival culture, not an event.

8. **Launching Pad for Marketplace Missional Entrepreneurs influencing the seven mountains of society.**

9. Planting Churches – God has given us a mandate to see churches planted in Charleston and Charlotte, as of now.

Praying for Sunday Service

1. Exodus 7:11 - Pray for the grounds, building, and the auditorium to be a place covered with the presence and power of the Holy Spirit. That the blood of Jesus would cleanse anything that would be a hindrance and obstacle from people experiencing God.

2. Phil 2:10-11. Take authority over the atmosphere, declaring that Jesus is Lord crushing every darkness and its deeds. Release and prophesy the anointing of the Holy Spirit will be upon the people, the chairs they will sit on, the ground in the center and upon every physical object that the worshippers will have direct contact with. Pray for an atmosphere of Fear of the Lord, atmosphere of Joy and peace. Atmosphere of father's love. Eze 37:9

3. Isaiah 43:6. Pray and prophesy that people will recognize and walk in the steps that God has ordered for them Sunday morning and come to church. Bind and rebuke every spirit that blinds and distract people from coming together for worship and serving the people of God. Pray for those people that church members have invited like their friends, family, neighbors, colleagues, and those that we have connected online, so that their hearts would be open, blindness would be removed, ears open to hear what the Holy Spirit is saying, and courage to follow and submit their lives to Lordship of Jesus. Mat 13:15

*Pray for the incarcerated, and human trafficked [Mt. 25:36]

*Pray for the Mentally & physically disabled [Luke 14:13,14 6

*Pray for the Foreigners [Exodus 22:21]

Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves, for the rights of all who are destitute. Speak up and judge fairly; defend the rights of the poor and needy. Prov. 31:8,9

*Pray that governmental leaders would have the moral and political courage to fulfill God’s Purpose

*Pray that governmental leaders would be surrounded with people of integrity and godly wisdom.

*Pray that each leader would have a “Daniel” to reveal the heart of God

*Pray that they would be of high moral character, sensitive to divine leadership, and strong enough to resist, political corruption

1. Our Nation and the Issues It Faces

Pray for the judges of this nation, that they will seek the wisdom that comes from above.

"But the wisdom that comes from heaven is first of all pure; then peace-loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere" ([James 3:17](#)).

Ask the Lord to thwart the efforts of those who would remove religious freedom.

"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery" ([Gal. 5:1](#)).

Pray for truth to become valued again in American society.

"Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free" ([John 8:32](#)).

Pray that our nation will increasingly see that God is our only refuge.

"God is our refuge and strength, an ever-present help in trouble" ([Ps. 46:1](#)).

Pray for our judicial system and lawmakers—that justice for all, tempered by mercy and compassion, will guide our nation.

"This is what the Lord Almighty said: 'Administer true justice; show mercy and compassion to one another'" ([Zech. 7:9](#)).

Repent on behalf of our nation, because we have turned from making Scripture the basis of law, leaving behind wisdom and instead, looking to ourselves for truth.

"We all, like sheep, have gone astray, each of us has turned to our own way; and the Lord has laid on him the iniquity of us all" ([Isa. 53:6](#)).

Pray that the United States will repent of its corporate rejection of the Word of God as the basis of law.

"How long will you who are simple love your simple ways? How long will mockers delight in mockery and fools hate knowledge? Repent at my rebuke! Then I will pour out my thoughts to you, I will make known to you my teachings" ([Prov. 1:22–23](#)).

Pray that a holy fear of God will sweep across our nation, leading us back to walking in the Lord.

"Who among you fears the Lord and obeys the word of his servant? Let the one who walks in the dark, who has no light, trust in the name of the Lord and rely on their God" ([Isa. 50:10](#)).

Pray for truth to be an established standard in our news media.

"In your majesty ride forth victoriously in the cause of truth, humility and justice; let your right hand achieve awesome deeds" ([Ps. 45:4](#)).

Pray that media bias will be replaced by fairness.

"The King is mighty, he loves justice-you have established equity; in Jacob you have done what is just and right" ([Ps. 99:4](#)).

Ask that Christianity will receive fair coverage in all reports.

"Have I not written thirty sayings for you, sayings of counsel and knowledge, teaching you to be honest and to speak the truth, so that you bring back truthful reports to those you serve?" ([Prov. 22:20–21](#)).

Pray for another Great Awakening to sweep the nation as the Lord's people learn to humble themselves with a contrite spirit, and to tremble at the Word of the Lord.

"'Has not my hand made all these things, and so they came into being?' declares the Lord. 'These are the ones I look on with favor: those who are humble and contrite in spirit, and who tremble at my word'" ([Isa. 66:2](#)).

Ask the Lord to bring revival to the Church in America.

"Oh, that you would rend the heavens and come down, that the mountains would tremble before you! As when fire sets twigs ablaze and causes water to boil, come down to make your name known to your enemies and cause the nations to quake before you! For when you did awesome things that we did not expect, you came down, and the mountains trembled before you. Since ancient times no one has heard, no ear has perceived, no eye has seen any God besides you, who acts on behalf of those who wait for him" ([Isa. 64:1-4](#)).

Pray for the preachers of America to fearlessly proclaim the Word of God regarding sin and God's love.

*Pray for people of integrity and moral character to be elected to these chambers.

*Pray that they would have strength to withstand political corruption.

*Pray that they would have vision and wisdom to pass the laws to promote domestic tranquility while keeping the nation safe internationally.

For the governor and state or provincial officials.

*Pray that the governor and state or provincial officials would see what is best for the state or province and not what is just politically expedient to satisfy lobbyists.

*Pray that they would be of high moral character, sensitive to divine leadership, and strong enough to resist, political corruption.

20. PRAY FOR OUR PRESIDENT & HIS TEAM

We pray for courage and strength for our President and His Team to follow the leading of the Holy Spirit and principles of the Word of God. *Psalms 21:7*

We pray that the heart and mind of our president and His team is Protected from any influence of the evil on. *2 Thessalonians 3:3*

We pray for discretion, foresight, and understanding in making decisions. *1 Chronicles 22:12*

We pray for our President and his team to have a tender heart of compassion toward those they are serving and will walk in love and confidence. *Colossians 3:12*

We pray that our President and His Team will uphold a strong standard of righteousness in our country. Rom 13:4

We pray that our President and his team will pursue peace, prosperity and continue to be a light for all nations for America [Jere 29:7, Isa 51:4]

21. PRAY FOR ISRAEL

Pray that every veil over hearts and minds would be removed and that eyes would be opened to the truth of the gospel (2 Corinthians 3:14–16).

5. Messianic Jewish Believers

Pray for encouragement, protection, boldness, and growth among Messianic Jewish believers and congregations within Israel and around the world.

Pray for Israel's leaders—governmental, military, and civic—to be guided by wisdom, discernment, and restraint.

7. Protection from Violence & Terror
